ON THE LOW BIRTH WEIGHT CRISIS IN LUCAS COUNTY**

Toledo, OH – On Thursday, November 4, at 8:00 p.m., WGTE TV will broadcast a Town Hall meeting on the low birth weight crisis in Lucas County. Taped before a live studio audience, Bill Harris hosts this important Town Hall, call-in event. In Lucas County there are huge disparities in birth weight outcomes based on where a mother lives. Suburban newborn weights are within healthy ranges; however, mothers in Toledo's inner-city neighborhoods have increased rates of low birth weight births. These babies are a higher risk for physical and developmental problems.
