This event is part of WGTE’s role as one of 20 stations in PBS KIDS Raising Readers, a national literacy campaign, and part of the Ready To Learn initiative, focused on building reading skills in preschoolers. The initiative is developing and testing engaging television programs, exciting games, playful Websites, and easy-to-use learning resources for kids, parents, caregivers, and teachers—all with the goal of helping children ages 2 to 8 get ready to read.
